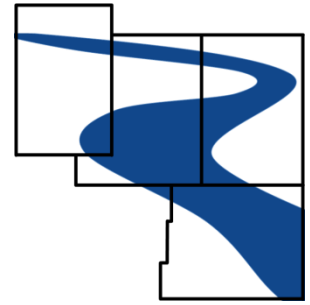


Upper Wabash River Watershed Management Plan ~Phase 2~
